

The GenAI4ED platform is being developed as a user-friendly digital environment that supports teachers, students, parents, guardians and education stakeholders in understanding, assessing and using Generative AI in education in a responsible and informed way.

It responds to the growing role of Generative AI in learning, teaching, content creation and problem solving, while addressing questions around trust, accuracy, ethics, safety, transparency, data protection and pedagogical value.

The platform is not simply a place to use AI tools. Its purpose is to help users understand which tools may be appropriate, how they can be used responsibly, and what risks or limitations should be considered before applying them in educational settings.

## What the platform does

The GenAI4ED platform brings together several services in one integrated environment:

- Interactive chatbot for questions, guidance and platform navigation.

- Training and Resource Hub with curated materials on Generative AI in education.

- Recommendation Engine to help identify tools that fit educational needs.

- Feedback and rating system to evaluate tools and platform features.

- Community space for structured discussions and knowledge exchange.

- Analytics dashboard for monitoring, evaluation and evidence-based improvement.

Through these services, the platform helps users move from general awareness of Generative AI to more informed and practical decision-making.

## Who the platform is intended for

The platform is designed for a wide range of users involved in secondary education.

### Teachers & educators

Explore Generative AI tools, access training resources, receive recommendations and reflect on how AI can support teaching, learning design, classroom activities, assessment preparation and student engagement.

### Students

Access information on the role of Generative AI in education, including opportunities, risks and implications for students' learning.

### School leaders, policymakers & stakeholders

Understand user needs, feedback, trends and challenges linked to the adoption of Generative AI in schools.

## How the platform supports teachers

Teachers are one of the key user groups of the GenAI4ED platform. It helps translate the complex and fast-changing landscape of Generative AI into practical, accessible and education-focused guidance.

### Through the platform, teachers will be able to:

- Access curated resources and training materials on Generative AI in education.
- Ask questions through an interactive chatbot and receive guidance based on platform resources.
- Search for or receive suggestions on tools suitable for subjects, grade levels and classroom contexts.
- Consider usefulness, relevance, accessibility, ethical implications and potential risks.
- Share feedback, participate in moderated discussions and contribute to continuous improvement.

In this way, the platform supports teachers not only as users of AI tools, but also as informed decision-makers who can critically assess when, why and how Generative AI should be used in educational practice.

## Supporting responsible and informed decision-making

GenAI4ED promotes responsible, transparent and human-centred use of Generative AI in education, with attention to accessibility, privacy, safety, role-based access and age-appropriate interaction.

The platform recognises that a teacher, a student, a parent and an administrator need different information and functionalities. Role-aware features help users access content, services and guidance that are relevant to their context.

Feedback and analytics mechanisms help the project understand how users engage with the platform, which tools and resources are most useful, and where further support is needed.

## Why the platform matters

The use of Generative AI in education cannot be addressed only from a technical perspective. It also requires pedagogical, ethical, social and practical understanding.

By combining guidance, resources, recommendations, feedback and community interaction, GenAI4ED brings these needs together in one shared environment and supports a more informed, inclusive and responsible approach to Generative AI in secondary education.
